



Adirondack Blue

Dark purple skin and flesh. High yields of large, oblong tubers with consistent, blue-violet flesh. Holds color when cooked. Deep eyes create a unique look. High in antioxidants.



Banana Fingerling

With tan skin and dark yellow flesh - one of the best-known fingerlings. Matures around 85 days with respectable yields. Delectable steamed and tossed with butter & parsley or in your favorite salad.



Kennebec

Excellent all-purpose potato. High yields of round-to-oblong tubers with buff skin & white flesh that store well. Widely adapted, fast-growing & do best when planted at 8-10" spacing to avoid overly large tubers.



Red Pontiac

Top-notch mashing potato! Produces solid tubers with thin red skins, shallow eyes, and crisp white flesh. They're also very flavorful at the new potato stage, so you may want to harvest a few then.



Russet Burbank

The most widely grown potato, it's often called the Idaho baking potato. Produces large, dependable yields of uniform, oblong, large, brown-skinned spuds. Its white, dry, flaky flesh bakes up perfectly.



Yukon Gold

A round tuber that has thin, smooth yellow skin with pink coloring around shallow eyes & yellow flesh. The best-selling early variety. This heirloom variety is great baked, boiled, or made into fries.
